- 2. FINDS that the proposed action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- 3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendations dated November 8, 2010 for this item.
- 4. AUTHORIZES entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority for the operation, management, and improvement of the Malibu Road Accessway.
- 5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Chairperson to execute the grant agreement and to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution; without limiting the generality of the foregoing, such authority shall include those provisions that he shall determine in the exclusive exercise of his discretion are necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolution and to comply with the policies of the Conservancy, and to otherwise carry out the provisions of state law and regulations.
