- 3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated February 28, 2011.
- 4. APPROVES the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority to use Coastal Habitat Impact Mitigation Funds to acquire APN 4444-023-010 in Topanga Canyon.
- 5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution.
