RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY AUTHORIZING ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHT TO APPLY FOR LOS ANGELES COUNTY 3RD SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT PROPOSITION A EXCESS FUNDS TO THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LAS VIRGENES TRAIL, MALIBU CANYON WATERSHED, CITY OF CALABASAS

WHEREAS, The proposed action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); Now

Therefore Be It Resolved, That the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy hereby:

- 1. FINDS that the proposed action is consistent with the Santa Monica Mountains Comprehensive Plan.
- 2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- 3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated February 28, 2011.
- 4. AUTHORIZES assignment of the right to apply for up to \$300,000 of 3rd Supervisorial District Specified Excess Funds to the Los Angeles County Department of Parks and Recreation for the Las Virgenes Trail Connector Project on County flood control rights-of-ways.
- 5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any
