#### VIRGINIA COLONY REGIONAL DETENTION BASIN GOALS

- Provide flood protection to Lower Calleguas (city of Moorpark and city if Camarillo)
- Implement and Maintain the sediment management strategy to minimize maintenance in system
- Provide opportunity for groundwater recharge
- Maximize multi-use and recreational benefits
- Perform cost-effective and environmentally friendly projects




# Lower Calleguas Creek IWPP Phase II Management Strategy Study Report Recommended Scenario

#### Regional Basins with Existing Structure Protection Level

- Regional Basins significantly reduce 100 year peak flood flows in Calleguas Creek and Revolon Slough.
- Minimized Channel Improvements.
- Land Management will maximize the amount of land that remains in (or is added to) the floodplain over time.
- Watershed BMPs will ensure that future flow peaks do not increase over current flows.


