RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY AUTHORIZING FINAL ADVANCE OF FUNDS TO THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY FROM CF-0907 FOR BROWNS CANYON RESTORATION PROJECT, UNINCORPORATED CHATSWORTH

WHEREAS, Restoration mitigation funding was provided to the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy Fund from Alamos Canyon ILF-Corps No. 200400766-MDC specifically for the Gopher Canyon tributary of the Brown's Canyon watershed of the Santa Susana Mountains; and

WHEREAS, The Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority owns and maintains the subject mitigation property; and

WHEREAS, The Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority has requested a final advance in the amount of \$269,980 from the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy Fund to continue the restoration work defined in CF-0907; and

WHEREAS, The staff report dated May 23, 2011 further describes the project; and

WHEREAS, The proposed action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); Now

Therefore Be It Resolved, That the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy hereby:

- 1. FINDS that the proposed action is consistent with the *Rim of the Valley Trail Corridor Master Plan* and the *San Gabriel and Los Angeles River Watershed and Open Space Plan* as adopted by the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy.
- 2. FINDS that the proposed action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- 3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated May 23, 2011.
- 4. AUTHORIZES an advance of the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy Fund (CF-0907) to the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority in an

amount not to exceed \$269,980 to complete the Gopher Canyon riparian restoration project associated with Alamos Canyon ILF-Corps No. 200400766-MDC in the Santa Susana Mountains.
