RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY AUTHORIZING  
THE ADDITION OF THE LAUREL CANYON – MULHOLLAND PROPERTIES  
PROJECT TO THE CONSERVANCY ACQUISITION WORKPROGRAM,  
CITY OF LOS ANGELES

WHEREAS, the Laurel Canyon - Mulholland Properties project is critical to the eastern Santa Monica Mountains wildlife corridor and the Mulholland Scenic Parkway; and

WHEREAS, The proposed project is consistent with the Santa Monica Mountains Comprehensive Plan; Now

*Therefore Be It Resolved*, That the Santa Monica Mountain Conservancy hereby:

1. FINDS that the proposed action is consistent with the Santa Monica Mountains Comprehensive Plan.
2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated June 27, 2011.
4. AUTHORIZES the addition of the Laurel Canyon - Mulholland Properties project to the Conservancy Workprogram.
5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution, and any recommendation made by the Governing Board.
