The Verdugo Hills Storm Water Project submitted by the Bureau of Sanitation is chalked with storm water, water quality, and public open space benefits. Few locations in the City can match the attributes of the subject 58.3-acre site in regards to this vast array of benefits.

With approximately 845 acres of urban and hillside watershed draining through the site, the project provides an optimal opportunity to clean and infiltrate great quantities of storm water in a centralized, gravity fed, low-maintenance-cost system. The proposed up front acquisition and development costs will soon pale compared to the long term economic relief and efficiency the project will offer in meeting State water quality and Federal Clean Water Act requirements and increasing groundwater supply.
