In order to establish the trees and provide water for the drinking fountain and bubbler, a drip irrigation system with an irrigation controller will be installed and a 1½ inch diameter water line will be installed, running from the Starland Drive cul-de-sac to the pocket park — a distance of approximately 1,600 feet.

#### III. PROJECT NEED

The Ultimate Destination Pocket Park has been a long-held dream of Ms. Elizabeth ("Liz") Blackwelder, a former President of the La Cañada Flintridge Trails Council, as well as the dream of the Board of Directors of the Trails Council. Ms. Blackwelder has donated \$35,000 of her own funds to see that this dream comes true, and has asked Los Angeles County to donate \$30,000. The funds are given because Ms. Blackwelder and the Trails Council realized that trail users, both people and horses, would get more use out of the City trail system if they were able to stop, get water, and rest in the shade for a few minutes. As trail users themselves, they knew that there was a perfect location at the end of the "Ultimate Destination" trail.

The Ultimate Destination Pocket Park will sit on a small plateau with 360-degree, sweeping views of the nearby mountains. Since the area is completely out in the open, it is usually overly warm, especially after having already used the trail. The dream of providing an oasis with shade trees and water for people and for horses will enable more people to use the trails, even during the warm weather.

The City encourages the use of its trails, and this is an excellent way to increase the recreational opportunities for the residents, thereby improving their quality of life, which certainly is the goal of the City.
