- 2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- 3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated December 3, 2012.
- 4. APPROVES the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority's use of Coastal Habitat Impact Mitigation Fund to acquire APN'S 4465-004-045 and 4465-004-084 in the Ramirez Canyon watershed.
- 5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution.
