RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF JOINT APPLICATION WITH THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY TO THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION FOR A COASTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TWO SUPERVISED, ADA-ACCESSIBLE CAMPSITES TO BE CLOSED ANNUALLY BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 15 AND JANUARY 15, A PORTION OF THE COASTAL SLOPE TRAIL, AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS IN RAMIREZ CANYON PARK AND ADJACENT PUBLIC PARKLAND; ALL SUCH IMPROVEMENTS TO BE LOCATED IN UNINCORPORATED LOS ANGELES COUNTY

WHEREAS, the 3.9 acre unincorporated portion of Ramirez Canyon Park is a unique site to provide ADA accessible camping within the Malibu Coastal Zone; and

WHEREAS, the unincorporated portion of Ramirez Canyon Park is critical to the alignment of the Coastal Slope Trail; and

WHEREAS, the unincorporated portion of Ramirez Canyon Park offers an excellent destination as a day use hike site and facilities stop for Coastal Slope Trail users; and

WHEREAS, the staff report dated January 7, 2013 further describes the project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project is consistent with the Santa Monica Mountains Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, The proposed actions are exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); Now

Therefore Be It Resolved, That the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy hereby:

- 1. FINDS that ADA accessible camping within the Malibu Coastal Zone is an important public need that can be well served in the unincorporated portion of Ramirez Canyon Park.
- 2. FINDS that Ramirez Canyon Park is critical to the completion of the Coastal Slope Trail and the ability to offer trail facilities between Kanan Dume Road and Latigo Canyon Road.

- 3. FINDS that the proposed action is consistent with the *Santa Monica Mountains Comprehensive Plan*.
- 4. FINDS that the proposed actions are categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- 5. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated January 7, 2013.
- 6. AUTHORIZES the submission of joint application with the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority to the California Coastal Commission for a coastal development permit for construction of two supervised, ADA-accessible campsites to be closed annually between September 15 and January 15, a portion of the Coastal Slope Trail, and related improvements in Ramirez Canyon Park and adjacent public parkland; all such improvements to be located in unincorporated Los Angeles County.
- 7. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution.
