- 4. APPROVES the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority's use of Coastal Habitat Impact Mitigation Fund to acquire APN'S 4465-004-045 and 4465-004-084 in the Ramirez Canyon watershed.
- 5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Chairperson to execute the grant agreement and to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution.
