Notes to Revenue Budget

- a. Actual 10-11 includes LVUSD camp fees now included in gov't agency contracts.
- b. Decrease in revenue for FY 12-13 and beyond is the sale of two easements in FY 11-12 for one-time funds.
- c. Building lease revenue down in FY 12/13 due to one property vacant for six months.
- d. Administrative Fees charged per section GC 53069.4 were reduced by MRCA Board effective March 1, 2012.
- e. Park Safety Fund surcharge was reduced by MRCA Board effective March 1, 2012.
- f. Decrease in FY 13/14 budget represents SMMC Proposition funding running down in the near future.
- g. Increase in FY 12/13 reflects 'one-time' \$250k allocation of brushing funds.
- h. New funding source - voter approved Community Facilities Districts (propositions HH and MM).
