



In its 29th year, the *California Trails & Greenways Conference* is expected to draw over 350 dedicated (non-motorized) trail professionals and volunteers from federal, state and local agencies, conservation and nonprofit organizations, students, advocates, and professional service and product providers. The Conference serves as a forum for networking and building support for accessible, inter-connected, quality trail systems; and as a venue for trail professionals and advocates to learn practical, up-to-date, trail skills. Hosted by *California State Parks* and the *California Trails Conference Foundation* our primary aim is to provide training and networking opportunities that will ensure effective trail stewardship and leadership for generations to come.

This 3-day event takes place April 8-10 at the Riviera Palm Springs. With the theme, **Interpretation -- Conveying Values, Promoting Stewardship, Creating Legacies**, we will explore how volunteers, advocates and agencies can convey trails' values in ways that promote support as treasured legacies for generations to come. The Conference theme, its 38 educational sessions on the full range of trail topics, and vital networking opportunities virtually guarantee stimulating and creative discussions during this 3-day training event. Join us as we study the challenges faced by our trail allies in this region, and learn from the inspiring successes they and other trail leaders from throughout California have achieved!
