- 5. AUTHORIZES acceptance of said grant and grant funding.
- 6. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer or his designee to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
- 7. AUTHORIZES the Chair to sign the grant application if the grant application is approved by the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy.
