RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY ASSIGNING THE RIGHT TO APPLY FOR PROPOSITION A BIG FIVE SPECIFIED EXCESS FUNDS FOR THE ESCONDIDO CANYON - STONE PROPERTIES TO THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY, UNINCORPORATED MALIBU AREA

WHEREAS, the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy is the designated recipient of Third Supervisorial District Proposition A Big Five Specified Excess Funds in the Santa Monica Mountains; and

WHEREAS, the staff report dated April 28, 2014 further describes the project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Escondido Canyon land acquisition project is consistent with the Santa Monica Mountains Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); Now

Therefore Be It Resolved, That the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy hereby:

- 1. FINDS that the proposed action is consistent with the Santa Monica Mountains Comprehensive Plan.
- 2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- 3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated April 28, 2014.
- 4. AUTHORIZES assigning the right to apply for \$535,000 of Proposition A Big Five Specified Excess Funds to the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority for the acquisition of 77.43 acres (APNs 4465-004-053 and 4465-005-006) in the Escondido Canyon watershed.
- 5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution.
