- 3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated July 28, 2014.
- 4. AUTHORIZES assignment of Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy's Proposition A Third Supervisorial District Big Five Excess Funds in the amount of \$1,215,000 to Mountains Restoration Trust for the Cold Creek Old Topanga acquisition project.
- 5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution.
