THIRD SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT FUNDS TO TRUST FOR PUBLIC LAND UPPER
RAMIREZ CANYON PHASE III ACQUISITION PROJECT,

WHEREAS, the Ramirez Canyon Phase III acquisition project is ecologically significant; and

2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated July 28, 2014.
4. AUTHORIZES assignment of Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy's Proposition A Third Supervisorial District Big Five Excess Funds to the Trust for Public Land for the Upper Ramirez Canyon Phase III acquisition project in the amount not to exceed \$700,000.
5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution.
