Grant Application - Proposition 84 Funds Ranger Interpretive Program Development

Dear Chairperson Parks and Conservancy Members:

I am pleased to present the enclosed application for a Ranger Interpretive Program Development of the Los Angeles River and its tributaries. The MRCA requests a grant in the sum of \$350,000 from the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84).

The proposed grant would fund a continued effort to develop and implement interpretive ranger led public programs within the Conservancy's jurisdiction. The western/upstream edge is the headwaters in Canoga Park, and it extends downstream along the main stem of the Los Angeles River to the point northeast of Griffith Park where the river turns south. The northern/upstream end is Hansen Dam, and it extends downstream along Tujunga Wash to the confluence with the Los Angeles River.
