Dear Mr. Haile:

In connection with the construction of the above project, the undersigned owner hereby grants to the Los Angeles County Flood Control District, its officers, agents, and contractor, permission to enter upon and occupy that portion of the property of the undersigned, designated as the above-captioned parcel, to be used for the purpose of constructing a rail and timber structure.

This permit to enter and to use the property of the undersigned is not a waiver in any way to the right to compensation to be paid for the acquisition of said parcel.

It is further understood that the undersigned will be paid the fair market value of said property and that said value will not be reduced by reason of the granting of this right of entry.

It is also understood that the undersigned has executed and delivered a Grant Deed to the Los Angeles County Flood Control District as to Parcel No. 1A, along with an invoice in the amount of \$45,360.00, and that this permit is for the purpose of allowing the District to enter and occupy Parcel No. 1A pending the processing, recording of Grant Deed, and payment of the compensation.

It is understood that the District, in exercising any rights under this right of entry, insofar as it may legally do so, assumes all risks and liabilities inherent in the construction of said structures and agrees to save the undersigned harmless from any damages whatsoever which might arise from the construction of said improvement.
