Project Description: As multiple planning efforts, development projects, and potential competing interests begin to shape the River's future Friends of the Los Angeles River endeavors to preserve and promote public access to the River. To accomplish this, FoLAR wishes to create adoptable land use standards to ensure public access is prioritized in all future projects and planning efforts. These standards will evaluate setbacks, public rights-of-way, and basic design considerations that are crucial in placemaking and driving an equitable public experience. This grant will help fund the development of best practice access and use standards for the Los Angeles River, using the Arroyo Seco Confluence area as the pilot site. The grant work will include renderings to support the proposed guidelines, and the coordination of stakeholders and will establish best practices for urban stream land use. The end result will be a set of guidelines as exemplified in the Arroyo Seco Confluence area and can be adopted River-wide. These guidelines will be used to help make decisions about potential capital improvements along the 31 mile stretch of the upper los angeles river watershed to ensure public access and ecological restoration priorities are included in project decisions.
