Project Description:

Acquired in 2003, the 2,326-acre property is located on the southern slopes of the Santa Susana Mountains between Chatsworth and Simi Valley. The park offers stunning vistas, rolling hills, oak and walnut woodland, water sources, and an abundance of wildlife. Browns Canyon Road is the primary access to the property and, along with Oat Mountain Motorway, one of few fire roads in the Santa Susana Mountains. The condition of the pavement in many sections has been deteriorating in the 11 years MRCA has held the property. Due to the very steep slopes, rebuilding these portions of the road after a washout would require major retaining structures for support.

The proposed grant augmentation will be used to implement natural and developed resource protection and restoration at Michael D. Antonovich Park at Joughin Ranch. The roadway improvements to Browns Canyon Road will protect natural and developed resources of the park and will support providing safe recreational access for the public, and to provide fire and life safety access to the undeveloped open spaces of the Santa Susana Mountains.
