RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE BALDWIN HILLS REGIONAL CONSERVATION AUTHORITY (BHRCA) AUTHORIZING ADOPTION OF A YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Baldwin Hills Regional Conservation Authority (BHRCA) was established by the County of Los Angeles (County) and the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy for the purpose of providing a comprehensive program to acquire, expand, and improve open space, natural habitat, and recreational opportunities within the Baldwin Hills and other natural and recreational areas within the Second Supervisorial District;

WHEREAS, BHRCA has the power to make and enter into contracts, and to employ agents and employees;

WHEREAS, BHRCA may have the need for tree planting, landscaping and site preparation work;

WHEREAS, BHRCA desires to adopt and implement a youth employment plan to employ at-risk youth directly or under contract with agencies that provide at-risk youth that meet the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District definition of at-risk youth, to perform such work;

WHEREAS, staff recommends proceeding with the adoption of a youth employment plan setting forth the employment of such at-risk youth; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Board of BHRCA hereby authorizes its Executive Director to take actions necessary to adopt such a youth employment plan.
