### **Background**

The Baldwin Hills Regional Conservation Authority (BHRCA) received over \$18 million dollars in Proposition A Excess Funds and \$7 million in Proposition A 1996 Funds to perform various acquisition and development projects within the 1,296-acre area of Baldwin Hills and along the 13-mile Park to Playa Trail corridor.

The project consists of the acquisition and the development of parcels of land for the Kenneth Hahn State Recreation Area within the approved boundary, which consists of up to 1,296 acres as well as for the acquisition of land and for the development of related recreation facilities and public access in the Baldwin Hills and along the Park to Playa Trail corridor.
