RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY ADOPTING TIERRA
REJADA VALLEY HABITAT LINKAGE HUB PLANNING MAP, COUNTY OF VENTURA

WHEREAS, The Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy (Conservancy) shall adopt Tierra Rejada Valley Habitat Linkage Hub Planning Map, County of Ventura; Now

Therefore Be It Resolved, That the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy hereby:

1. FINDS that this action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
2. FINDS that a comprehensive planning map for the subject area is essential to ensure adequate long term habitat connectivity between the Santa Susana Mountains and Simi Hills and to the Montclef Ridge area.
3. ADOPTS a Tierra Rejada Valley Habitat Linkage Hub Planning Map with the expectation that staff will update the map as properties become either developed or permanently protected.
4. AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution.
