**1. Call to order.**

The 467<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy and Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy Advisory Committee was called to order by Chairperson Irma R. Muñoz at 10:08 a.m. on August 31, 2020 at various locations via internet and telephone pursuant to Executive Order N-29-20.

**2. Roll Call of Conservancy.**
